Traveling to the Museum of the Albemarle for a presentation: “Early Coastal North Carolina Quakers and Slavery”. Quakers from Virginia and New England arrived in coastal North Carolina from the 1650s into the early 1700s. Surprisingly, many were enslavers who forced enslaved people to labor on Quaker farms in the colony. J Timothy Allen, PhD, professor of humanities at Strayer University will discuss the early North Carolina Quakers’ attitudes toward slavery and how and why they progressed from slavery to manumission.
