Chair Amy Spaugh called the meeting to order and turned it over to Superintendent Cheeseman. Mr. Cheeseman explained that they had provided a revised 2018-2019 Capital Outlay Budget sheet which had been placed at each member's seat.

SCHOOL FUNDING: 2018-2019

Superintendent Cheeseman explained that their budget requests falls into three categories: Safety; Personnel; and Construction. He reviewed each section with the Board citing these items and the Boards discussed each item individually:

Desire four SRO Officers
Increase Budget for Metal Detectors for schools & school events = cost \$16,000
Explore the possibility of using part-time retired personnel to fill SRO positions

Get Classified Staff to 80% = cost \$120,000 Other Staff = increase teacher supplements to 4% = cost \$90,000 Discussed need for greater funding for health/science teachers Reviewed the Capital Outlay Request sheet = cost \$991,900

The biggest discussion was on the Safety of our schools. The two Boards had an open forum discussion.
