### **AEMT to Paramedic Course**

#### **Student Prerequisites:**

1. Valid NCEMS, NREMT or other states AEMT credential
2. High school diploma or high school equivalency
3. Current AHA BLS CPR
4. Successful completion of college-level English, or within the previous 12 months complete a written assessment placing the individual into college-level English.
5. Successful completion of college-level Math, or within the previous 12 months complete a written assessment placing the individual into college-level Math.

#### **Prerequisite/Corequisite**

Basic Anatomy and Physiology (EMS 3163 or equivalent) that meets or exceeds the requirements listed in the NC Community College System. (See Basic A&P Course if you need this course for the prerequisite)
