Public Schools	Grades K-5 transitioned to Plan A on Monday, October 19, 2020 after recent board approval and collaboration from Albemarle Regional Health Services. While social distancing is recommended in Plan A, it is not required for the classrooms or buses even though the school still intends to social distance students as much as possible. Other safety precautions such as health screenings, masks, and disinfection procedures will remain as they are today. High School will add another shortened in-person instructional day per week starting January 2021.
