<b>Public Schools</b>	Grades 6-12 will transition to Plan A on Monday, March 22, 2021 after a recent change in legislation signed by Governor Cooper. Grades K-5 made this transition in October 2020. While social distancing is recommended in Plan A, it is not required for the classrooms or buses even though the school still intends to social distance students as much as possible. Other safety precautions such as health screenings, masks, and disinfection procedures will remain as they are today.
