### **Perquimans County Encourages Residents to Participate in Broadband Survey**

**Perquimans County, NC** – Perquimans County announced the launch of the Perquimans County Broadband Survey this week and is urging all residents and businesses to participate in the survey by July 31st, 2021.

“This survey is critical in helping Perquimans County identify areas in the county that do not have access to high-speed internet,” commented Frank Heath, Perquimans County Manager. “The information we get back will help us determine the geographic areas most in need and it will allow the county to work collaboratively with internet service providers to find solutions that can bring high-speed internet to these areas.”

The survey will provide justification for Perquimans County to qualify for much needed state and federal broadband grant funds that will be made available to expand broadband service into areas where residents and businesses do not have access to qualifying broadband service of at least 25/3 megabits.
