March 25th - Medical Clearance and Respirator Fit Testing

The EPA has recently revoked the respirator fit test exemption for growers, and they now require that growers be fit tested for 2021. There will be a medical clearance and fit testing event at the Chowan County Extension office at 730 N Granville St, Edenton, on March 25th from 8:30 - 2:30. Growers must register ahead of time to sign up for one of several hour-long time slots. There is a limit of 12 people per time slot. Both the medical clearance and the fit testing will be \$40 per person (\$80 together). If you wish, you can go to your primary care doctor to get a medical clearance ahead of time.
