

ServSafe Food Safety Class offered March 29-31, 2022

Chowan County Cooperative Extension will be offering the ServSafe Food Safety Class, March 29-31, 2022.

ServSafe is a course designed by the National Restaurant Association Educational Foundation to provide foodservice operators, managers, and support personnel with the knowledge essential for food preparation and handling within their respective facilities to help reduce the risk of food-borne illness. The course covers handling food, from receiving and storing to preparing and serving. It gives science-based information on how to run a safe establishment.

This is a 14-hour class to be held at Chowan Ag. Building, 730 N. Granville St. Edenton NC in the Large Conference Room. Classes will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m.

March 29-30th 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. **March 31st**, 9-11:00 a.m. **Exam**

Registration cost is \$125 (which includes the 7th edition book and exam sheet.)
