Thanks to a grant from Vidant Community Foundation, and in collaboration with community partners and the Chowan, Gates and Perquimans County Extension Master Gardener program, food pantry clients are eligible to receive an at-home gardening kit this month. The kits, which include easy-to-grow vegetable seeds, growing containers and how-to information, are part of a program established in 2016 by local Master Gardeners. To increase the number of residents growing food for home consumption, while overcoming unique challenges of rural access, like transportation, the Chowan, Gates and Perquimans County Extension Master Gardeners annually host Grow To Eat. The out-of-the-box community garden project provides horticulture education to residents receiving assistance through community food pantry programs.
