4-H Farm to Fork Cooking Camp

Our recent Farm to Fork Cooking Camp was a tremendous success, engaging twelve enthusiastic kids aged 10+ in a three-day culinary adventure. The camp kicked off with lessons on kitchen safety and knife skills, followed by interactive activities on foodborne illnesses and the importance of properly washing your hands. The children explored grill types, visited Snow Hill Farms to learn about cuts of meat, and made their own sausage at Layden's Country Store. They also cooked a variety of meals, including homemade pasta, "breakfast for lunch," and burgers with fries, honing their culinary skills and understanding the journey of food from farm to table.









After School with the Dance Company of Hertford

The Perquimans County 4-H partnered with The Dance Company of Hertford to provide activities to kids in their afterschool program. Since February, we have been working together once a month. We have painted bricks for the food bank community garden, talked about financial literacy and created our own savings jars, planted lettuce and learned about plant needs, and tried our lettuce in a fun taste test to learn more about lettuce varieties and purposes. We will continue this partnership and bring new programs once school is back in session!






Extension Master Gardener Course

ServeSafe Class

Calling all those in the restaurant and food service industry! N.C. Cooperative Extension will be offering a ServSafe Food Safety Class in July. The class will be held at the N.C. Cooperative Extension, Perquimans County Center, and will begin promptly at 9 a.m. each day. ServSafe is a course designed by the National Restaurant Association Educational Foundation to provide food service operators, managers, and support personnel with the knowledge essential for food preparation and handling within their respective facilities to help reduce the risk of foodborne illness. The course covers handling food, from receiving and storing to preparing and serving. It gives science-based information on how to run a safe establishment.

The 14-hour class will be scheduled as follows:

Progressive Ag Safety Day

Safety in and around the home is a major issue that needs to be addressed. Studies show that kids are spending more time home alone, including before and after school, summer vacations, and holidays.

In response to this, the Perquimans County Cooperative Extension staff, along with community volunteers including 811, NC Wildlife Service, and the United States Coast Guard, and Albemarle EMC worked together to conduct a Progressive Safety Day event reaching approximately 140 3rd graders. Topics included were wildlife safety, digging safety, backyard safety, agriculture safety, electric safety, chemical safety, germ safety, and water safety.
