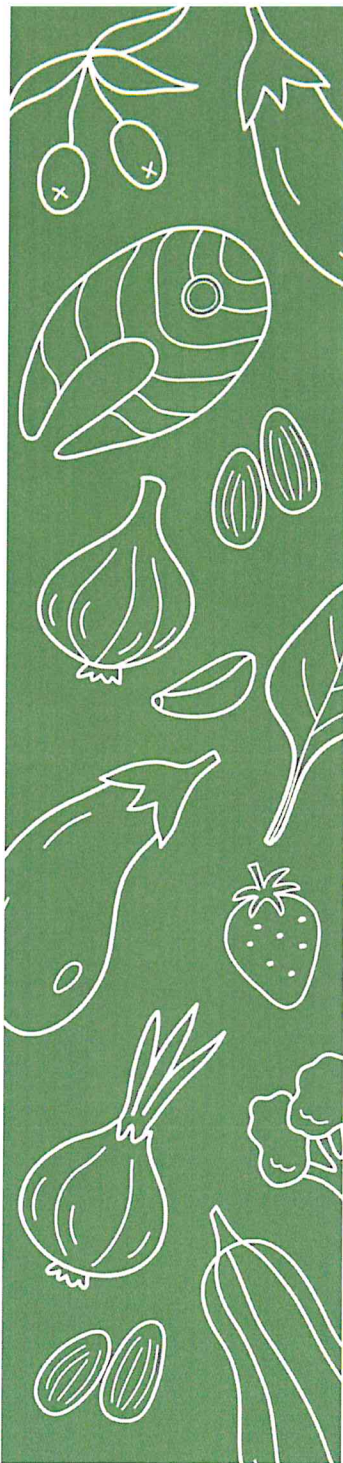

New Fumigation Certification

The Pasquotank Extension Center located at 1209 McPherson Street will be cooperating with the North Carolina Department of Agriculture & Consumer Services, Pesticide Section, to host a testing site for the new private (farmer) category, Z(CF), commodity fumigation on Monday, September 23 starting at 1:00 p.m. Farmers that want to fumigate grain bins and/or loads of grain on trucks must have this certification. The North Carolina Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Pesticide Section will be having a number of these testing sites across North Carolina initially to get farmers certified in this category, but there will be other opportunities in the future as more farmers need this certification. 2024 North Carolina Cattle Industry Assessment Referendum

Date: Thursday, October 30, 2024

Time: 8:30am - 5:00pm

Location: Perquimans Extension Office

Eligibility: Any North Carolina resident who can claim ownership of cattle, either beef or dairy. An owner must sign an affidavit sheet claiming age, ownership, and residency.

Ballot Specifics: "Yes" indicated a vote in favor of continuing the state assessment program. "No" indicates a vote against continuing the state assessment program.
