Pumpkins must be picked up by October 31st

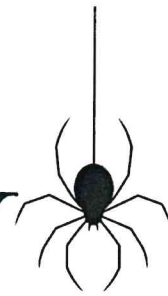
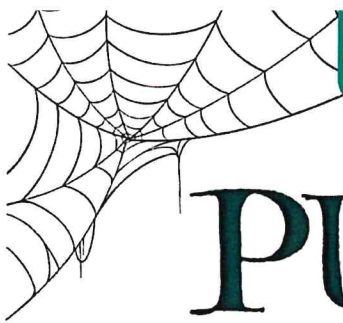

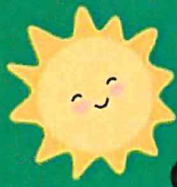
