




Want to create a blooming garden or raise honey bees? Dive into this exciting adventure with NC Cooperative Extension!

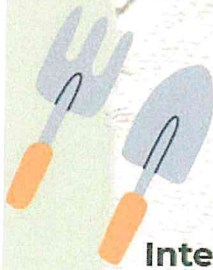

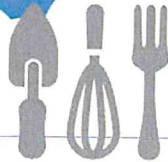
